

**RCI 2021 COVID Protocols**  
**(As of May 20, 2021 we are planning to run camps at Tier 0.5)**

**Tier 0.5 Expectations:**

- A camper may not attend camp if they are waiting for the results of a COVID-19 test but may attend late with the camp director's permission if the results are negative; campers may not attend if they have had a positive test within the 10 days immediately prior to the start of camp
- A camper should not attend camp if they have been exposed to COVID within 14 days or have symptoms of COVID.
- Cabins are considered to be a cohort group.
- Temperature checks and standard COVID questions at registration
- Campers may be sent home according to the RCI 2021 COVID Protocol for Nurses Flow Chart
- Once a day sanitizing of high touch surfaces
- Hand sanitizing stations will be set up at key locations (start of food line, etc)
- No campers allowed in the kitchen for KP duty. (CITs &/or staff will do it this year)

**Tier I Expectations:**

- A camper may not attend camp if they are waiting for the results of a COVID-19 test but may attend late with the camp director's permission if the results are negative; campers may not attend if they have had a positive test within the 10 days immediately prior to the start of camp
- Cabins are considered to be a cohort group. No masks will be required when outdoors, in the cabin as a cohort group, or while actively eating. (Outdoors includes open-air structures such as the tabernacle at Odessa Hills campground and Happy Hollow cabins if all windows are open and fans are going.)
- Mask wearing is required for all campers and staff while indoors. (Indoors include spaces such as the dining hall at Odessa Hills.) Medical exemptions or doctor's notes for masks will not be accepted.
- Masks shall be worn over both the nose and the mouth.
- Only masks provided by RCI shall be worn during camp. RCI will provide disposable, 3-layer masks for camper use. Campers will not use their own mask.
- Campers must submit a Waiver of Liability re Covid 19 signed by a parent or guardian prior to attending camp
- Staff must submit a signed Waiver of Liability re Covid 19 prior to start of camp
- Temperature checks and standard covid questions at registration
- Campers may be sent home according to the RCI 2021 Covid Protocol for Nurses Flow Chart
- Once a day sanitizing of high touch surfaces
- Hand sanitizing stations will be set up at key locations (start of food line, etc)
- No campers allowed in the kitchen for KP duty. (CITs &/or staff will do it this year)

**Tier II Expectations:**

- All of Tier I, plus:
- Distance between persons will be increased outdoors whenever possible.
- Cohort groups will sit at assigned locations for all indoor activities that don't allow for 6 feet distancing (dining hall / classrooms, etc.)
- High touch surfaces will be sanitized multiple times a day
- Cohort shower routine (scheduled shower time, wipe down knobs between cabins)
- No buffet lines

Dr. Kendal Geno will be on call for phone conferences with camp nurses to make decisions for specific possible COVID-19 cases.

**Note: RCI reserves the right to change or add to these Covid Protocols as circumstances may dictate. If changes occur to these protocols we will notify all those registered and post the new guidelines.**

**Unadopted Possible Restriction Menu:**All of Tier I and II, plus:

- Daily temperature checks
- Outdoor mask wearing
- Cohorts for dining/classes (dining shifts - to decrease capacity)
- Clean each space after use
- Assigned seating for meals

**Mountain Camp:**

May cancel second Mt Camp depending on first camp issues

Masks used in park bathrooms, rest stops, restaurants, and anywhere else required by city or state ordinances

Directors to bring a quarantine tent

Parent must agree to pick up child within 24 hrs, if the need arises

**COVID Advisory Counsel:**

A small group 2-3 board members to assist Aaron Bailey in unique emergency situations that will arise due to COVID

**Mammoth Camp Cleaning Plan - Lake of the Ozarks State Park**

For final cleaning procedures.

**Cabins:**

Each counselor will be issued cleaning products for their cabin.

Each cabin will wipe all shared surfaces in their cabin space (beds, shelves, door touch points)

Each cabin's floor will be swept

**Bathrooms:**

A cabin will be assigned to clean bathrooms, cleaning touchpoints, and floors.

**Indoor class/meeting spaces:**

A cabin will be assigned to clean class/meeting rooms. This includes sweeping floors and sanitizing touch points.

**Kitchen:**

Kitchen staff will mop floors and sanitize all surfaces.

**Dining Hall:**

Will be swept and mopped

Tables and other high touch surfaces will be wiped down.

**WAIVER OF LIABILITY RELATING TO CORONAVIRUS / COVID-19**

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is reported to be extremely contagious. The state of medical knowledge is evolving, but the virus is believed to be spread person to person contact and/or by contact with contaminated surfaces and objects, and even possibly in the air. People reportedly can be infected and show no symptoms and therefore unknowingly spread the disease. The exact methods of spread and contraction are unknown. Evidence has shown that COVID-19 can cause serious potentially life-threatening illness and even death.

Restoration Camping Incorporated (RCI) cannot prevent you or your child(ren) from becoming exposed to, contracting or spreading COVID-19 while attending RCI Camps. It is not possible to prevent against the presence of the disease. Therefore, if you choose to utilize RCI camps, and/or enter camp premises you may be exposing yourself to and/or increasing your risk of contracting or spreading COVID-19.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I have read and understood the above warning concerning COVID-19. I hereby choose to accept the risk of contracting COVID-19 for myself and/or my child(ren) in order to utilize RCI camps and/or be on the grounds during/before/after camps.

WAIVER OF LAWSUIT/LIABILITY: I hereby forever release and waive my right, and my child's right, to bring suit against RCI and its agents and employees, volunteers, board members and other representatives in connection with exposure, infection and/or spread of COVID-19 related to utilizing RCI's services or camps. I understand that this waiver means I give up my right to any claims including for personal injuries, death, disease or property losses, or any other loss, including but not limited to claims of negligence and give up any claim I may have to seek damages whether known or unknown, foreseen and unforeseen.

ASSUMPTION OF LIABILITY: I assume all liability for myself, and/or for any claim which a minor signing this document with me may have, now or any time in the future, relating to this agreement and/or attendance at an RCI camp. Further, I assume liability for any claim which could be raised by any non-signing parent or guardian, both for themselves or on behalf of any minor whose signature appears below with mine.

CHOICE OF LAW: I understand and agree that the law of the State of Missouri will apply in the contract.

I HAVE CAREFULLY READ AND FULLY UNDERSTAND ALL PROVISIONS OF THIS RELEASE, AND FREELY AND KNOWINGLY ASSUME THE RISKS AND WAIVE MY RIGHTS CONCERNING LIABILITY AS DESCRIBED ABOVE. I HAVE BEEN ADVISED TO CONSULT AN ATTORNEY FOR ANY QUESTIONS I MAY HAVE ABOUT THIS LEGAL DOCUMENT. .
